



Head Start Alumni Scholarship

In partnership with the Head Start Alumni Scholarship—Community Action Council will award \$6,000 in scholarships for the upcoming 2022-2023 academic year to four Head Start alumni entering college.

For 57 years, Head Start has remained a leader in providing comprehensive education, health, nutrition, and parent involvement services to children from families with low income throughout the United States. Community Action Council provides high-quality early childhood education at our Prep Academies located throughout 13 counties and through partnerships with school systems and community-based early childhood providers.

The Head Start Alumni Scholarship will be awarded to a deserving individual as laid out by the criteria below. The scholarship is intended to cover a portion of tuition at a post-secondary institution.

- The applicant must be a Head Start Alumnus from an accredited Head Start program;
- The applicant must be entering their first year in a two-year or four-year college or university;
- The applicant must be admissible at an accredited college or university;
- The applicant must have a high school diploma or equivalent;
- The applicant must be a resident of--or attend school in—the counties of Bourbon, Clark, Estill, Fayette, Garrard, Harrison, Jackson, Laurel, Madison, Nicholas, Powell, Rockcastle, or Scott;
- The applicant must maintain a cumulative 2.5 GPA to keep the scholarship.

The deadline to apply is 5:00 p.m. EST Friday, April 15, 2022. Applications received after that time will not be reviewed.

Instructions:

1. Prepare all application materials well in advance.

- Consider all criteria for the scholarship before applying to ensure you meet the requirements.
- Fill out the application form and attach additional sheets as necessary.
- Compose an essay that will help the selection committee understand how the Head Start Alumni Scholarship can help you achieve your goals attending a two-year or four-year college and why you should be an award recipient. The essay should not exceed 1,000 words.
- Include full contact information for yourself as well as your parent(s) or guardian(s).
- Submit one official transcript from the high school you most recently attended. Applications without accompanying transcripts will not be considered.
- Include an Institutional Student Information Record (ISIR) from the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) from the school you wish to attend.
- Submit one letter of recommendation (letters of recommendation may come from teachers, supervisors or community members).

2. The application packet **MUST** be received by Friday, April 15, 2022 by 5:00pm.

The Details

- Each awardee must submit enrollment verification at a post-secondary institution to Community Action Council, c/o Camisha Powell, PO Box 11610, Lexington, KY 40576 by August 1, 2022.
- Checks will be paid directly to the post-secondary institution upon verification of enrollment.
- Failure to complete these steps will result in the forfeiture of the scholarship award.
