Practice saying the alphabet together. Toss a ball back and forth with your child and take turns saying a letter at a time.	Using a standard deck of cards, take out the cards that represent the quantities one to five (you can use 1-10 if they know 1-5). Use them to play games including go fish and memory with your child to help them recognize quantities by sight.	Fill a giant Ziploc bag with hair gel and food coloring, if needed. Write their name or other words on a piece of paper. Lay the sealed gel bag over the paper and let your child trace the letters.	Label stairs or make labels on the floor with numbers written on paper and throw bean bags to land on each stair or paper. Make it harder by having your child work to land the beanbag on numbers in order. If you don't have a beanbag use rolled up socks!	Play a game like Candyland, Go Fish, Old Maid, Chutes and Ladders. Practice taking turns. Have your child use "self talk" to remember the steps for taking a turn.
