Ask your child to name that letter.	Kitchen Timer Race Use a kitchen timer to time how fast your child can complete simple tasks, like picking up toys or stacking cups. This helps with number recognition and the concept of time.	Finger Painting Use this activity to allow your child to get creative and messy! See how many shapes they can paint or help them write their name!	Jumping Over Objects Set up soft pillows or toys on the floor and have your child jump over them. This helps develop leg strength and agility.	Kindness Rocks Paint small rocks with messages of kindness and leave them around the house. Talk about the meaning behind each message.
